LOCATION AND SPECIFICATIONS

- This Trial will be held, rain or shine, at GUIDES CANINS 1200A montée Poirier, Saint-Lazare, outside, on a sandy grass surface.

- It will be held according to the regulations and sanctioned by the Canadian Disc Dog Association (CDDA).
- An electronic timer will be used for all the events.

ELIGIBILITY

- To participate in this competition, purebred or mixbred dogs must be at least 12 months old (14 weeks for the RPT) and must have a CDDA identity card.
- Junior handlers must also have an CDDA ID number.

REGISTRATION, FEES & PAYMENTS

- Competitors, through the submission of entry, acknowledge that they know the CDDA rules.
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- Registrations open 1 month before the first day of the event.
- Registrations close the Monday before the event or when the limit is reached.
- For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries accepted.
- The classes cost \$17,50+tx, RPT classes cost \$13,50+tx before the closing date.
- It will be possible to register after the closing date or on site, if there is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$22+tx.
- Google Form online registration only. No paper version. Please phone us to register over the phone if you have trouble or if you don't have access to a computer: 450-424-1469.
- The release form must be signed to satisfy AAC registration requirements.
- An invoice will be sent to you by email. Payment must be made promptly upon receipt of this invoice. Registration will be valid only after receipt of payment.
- Payment can be made by electronic transfer to info@guidescanins.com with the answer to the question: your dog's name in all small letters without spaces, without accent or by credit card directly from your portal.
- Participants canceling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.

- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours of the start of the first day they are registered.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.

PROGRESS

- Official discs must be used in all Disc Dog events. You can find a list of approved disc at: <u>www.canadiandiscdogs.com/rules.cfm</u>. You must supply your own disc or buy one on site. All disc used in Freestyle classes must be of the exact same type disregarding colours 8 logos. All flying discs are subject to inspection.
- Registration opens 1 hour before the start of the trial.
- Running Orders will be posted on site.
- Results, ribbons and score sheet copies will be given at the end of the Trial.
- The results will be posted on site and sent by email at the end of the day.
