

## GUIDES CANINS DISC DOG SCHOOL TESTS

## IMPORTANT! FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

- These School Tests, sanctioned by the CDDA, will take place at *GUIDES CANINS*, outside, on a grass surface, rain or shine. Tests will start at around 6pm and will finish before the sun sets.
- Participants, through the submission of entry, acknowledge that they know the CDDA rules and regulations.
- These tests are open to all dogs, purebred and non purebred that are at least 12 months of age (14 weeks of age for the RPT) and that have a CDDA ID number.
- Junior handlers must also have a CDDA ID number.
- Entries are limited. we reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- The registration form is available on our website.
- An invoice will be sent to you by email. Payment must be made promptly after receipt of this invoice.
   Registration will be valid only after receipt of payment.
- Payment can be made by electronic transfer to info@guidescanins.com with the answer to the question
  your dog's name in all small letters without spaces, without accent or by credit card directly from your
  account.
- The classes cost \$17,50+tx, RPT and junior handler classes cost \$13,50+tx before the closing date.
- For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries accepted.
- The closing date of the pre-registration will be the Sunday before the test.
- It will be possible to register on site but the price of the runs will be \$22 +tx.
- An electronic timer will be used.
- A copy of your score sheet will be available after all the classes.
- Qualifying ribbons will be given to all participants who qualify. Rosettes from the first to the sixth place will be awarded to the winners of each class.
- Official discs must be used in all Disc Dog events. You can find a list of approved disc at: <u>www.canadiandiscdogs.com/rules.cfm</u>. You must supply your own disc or buy one on site. All flying discs are subject to inspection.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants cancelling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and handlers that are injured, providing
  that they send a doctor or veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours of
  the start of the first day they are registered.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.
