LOCATION AND SPECIFICATIONS

- This test will be held at GUIDES CANINS 1200A montée Poirier, Saint-Lazare, indoors, in the old building <http://www.guidescanins.com/en/facilities/directions/>

- Snow or shine!
- It will be held according to the regulations and sanctioned by the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC).
- Only official scents will be used in all CKC events, you can find a list of approved scents and rules at <https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Scent-Detection-Trial-Rules-and-Regulations>.

ELIGIBILITY

- All dogs (pure breed, unrecognized breed, mixed breed) must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration.
- Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the award/titles earned, the non-member will have the choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only for dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

REGISTRATION, FEES & PAYMENTS

- Competitors, through the submission of an entry, acknowledge that they know and accept the CKC rules. www.ckc.ca.
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- Handler/dog teams may enter one, two or all three components. A handler may enter a maximum of 1 dog in a given component.
- Dogshow.ca registration opens one month prior to the event.
- Registrations close at 11:59 p.m. 2 Mondays before the event or when the limit is reached.
- In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs.
- Each component & costs \$41.60+tx/component before the closing date (Instinct test as well). It will be possible to register after the closing date, if there is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$50+tx/component
- Dogs with Temporary Competition Numbers (TNC) will be charged \$10.50 per component.
- For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries are not accepted.

- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants canceling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and/or handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or a veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised at least 24 hours before the time of the registration of the first day of the test.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.
- A \$20 fee will be charged for NSF checks and refused credit cards.

PROCEDURE

- An email with general instructions and running orders will be sent the Wednesday before the event.
- A copy of your scoresheet will be sent to you via email at the end of the trial.
- A ribbon will be awarded to each team earning a qualifying score. Title ribbons will be awarded for each title.
- The results will be posted on site and published on the DogShow.ca website, as soon as possible
