



IMPORTANT! FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

- This match will take place at GUIDES CANINS, will be held under modified AAC rules, on a synthetic surface, in a 65' X 100' indoor hall;
- Dogs must be 12 months or older;
- Food & toys welcome!
- Registration is limited to approximately 220 runs;
- We reserve the right to refuse entries;
- Entries close at noon the Wednesday before the match or when the Match is full;
- The cost is \$7.50 per run for GUIDE CANINS students and \$9.50 for others.
- It will be possible to register or add runs on-site (if the limit number has not been reached). The price of those added runs will be \$12;
- This Match will be judged by a licensed or want to be judge;
- Runs will be scribed and timed;
- The standard course time will be 60 seconds;
- The maximum course time will be 120 seconds;
- If you do not follow the sequence of the course or if you repeat an obstacle, you will have 60 seconds to play:
- For the Snooker, in the event that the team is eliminated in opening, it can continue playing for 60 seconds;
- The scribe sheets will be available at the end of each dog's run;
- No results will be scored or published. No prizes or rosettes will be awarded;
- All levels (Starters, Advanced and Masters) will be nested. Only the Starters courses will be numbered;
- Course maps will be available for all the participant;
- Course walking will be done as a single group, all levels at the same time. If need be, we'll
 be splitting the walk through;
- Running orders will be small dogs followed by big dogs. Regular first. It will only be available on site;
- A confirmation and an approximate schedule will be sent by email, the Thursday before the Match;
- The 1st dog on the line will be at 9am. We will break for lunch, The day will finish at around 5pm;
- Plan to bring your lunch. Microwaves will be available;
- There shall be NO REFUND.
